4. Assessment structure

Component	Weight	Description
Legal opinions and memoranda	40-60%	Fully cited advisory documents assessed on reasoning and authority handling.
Drafting portfolios	20-40%	Contracts, clauses, policies and pleadings with drafting notes.
Oral advocacy	0-20%	Recorded submissions and research-design defences.
Thesis and defence	30 credits	Independent legal research with an oral defence.

5. Master's thesis (30 credits)

A 15,000–20,000 word thesis, most commonly doctrinal or comparative. Empirical projects require ethics screening before data collection begins.

Milestone timeline

- Month 1: research question, supervisor allocation, source strategy
- Month 2: authority map and literature chapter
- Month 3: substantive analysis chapters
- Month 4: comparative or empirical component
- Month 5: full draft and supervisor feedback
- Month 6: submission, similarity check and oral defence
