A graduate management degree for leaders of organisations that operate under regulatory supervision, with a distinctive medical-law core.

1. Program overview

The MBA of Middle West University is built for practising managers. It assumes prior exposure to organisational life and moves quickly from description to decision: what should be done, on what evidence, under what legal constraint, and who carries the consequence.

What distinguishes the programme is its compulsory legal spine. Corporate governance, provider liability, health data protection and dispute resolution are taught as management subjects, not as optional legal decoration, because in regulated sectors legal exposure is an operating variable.

Every module combines recorded lectures, a slide dossier, a case pack and an applied deliverable that can normally be used inside the student's own organisation.

2. Admission requirements

Bachelor's degree or at least 3 years of managerial experience

3. Mode of study

Fully online, asynchronous study with scheduled tutorial consultations

4. Who the program is for

- Clinic, hospital and laboratory directors moving from professional to executive responsibility
- Compliance, quality and risk officers in health care and insurance
- Consultants and advisers serving regulated clients
- Experienced managers from other sectors entering health care or life sciences

5. Learning outcomes

On successful completion of the program, graduates are able to:

- Formulate and defend a corporate strategy under regulatory and reimbursement constraints
- Design a governance and compliance architecture with clear lines of accountability
- Assess liability exposure arising from clinical and commercial activity and mitigate it
- Build the financial case for an institutional investment and stress-test its assumptions
- Lead a negotiation and select the appropriate dispute-resolution route
- Plan and execute an independent applied research project to master's standard

7. Tuition and payment

9. Assessment and academic integrity

Applied deliverables — 50-70%

Programmes, dossiers, opinions and board packs usable in practice.

Simulations — 10-40%

Recorded negotiations, breach drills and client presentations.

Written examinations — 0-40%

Used where standardised knowledge testing is appropriate.

Thesis and defence — 30 credits

Independent applied research with an oral defence.

All submitted work passes an automated similarity check. Plagiarism, undisclosed collaboration and the undeclared use of generative tools are academic offences and are handled under the university's academic integrity procedure.

10. Frequently asked questions

I do not have a bachelor's degree. Can I still apply?

Yes. At least three years of documented managerial experience is an accepted alternative entry route.

Can I write the thesis about my own employer?

Yes, and most students do. A confidentiality annex protects sensitive data while allowing academic assessment.

How much time per week should I plan?

Around 18–22 hours per week during teaching semesters, more during the thesis semester.

Is the legal core taught for lawyers?

No. It is taught for managers who must make decisions with legal consequences and know when to instruct counsel.
